Choices' Community Provider Network is what allows us to individualize a treatment plan around a youth and family – not fit youth into the same plan that everyone receives.

Choices openly invites providers of emotional, behavioral and mental health services to join our growing provider network, as well as low cost / no cost

providers, those who offer informal supports, and providers who do not currently hold a DCS contract. Providers are supported with a wide range of technical and business tools to help them effectively partner with Choices programs.
